

Millions raised by diplomats will help Czech charities

Help for victims of crime or domestic violence, rehabilitation equipment, school transport for disabled children, material support for home hospices, musical instruments for disadvantaged children and equipment for the visually impaired are only a few examples of 29 Czech philanthropic projects that will be supported by money raised by diplomats from more than 50 countries.

The International Christmas Festival, organized under the auspices of the First Lady by the **Diplomatic Spouses Association** on the first Advent Sunday last Christmas, took thousands of visitors on a tour around the world. This annual festival and market raised almost **2.1 million CZK** for Czech charities by selling entry tickets, goods from all over the world, internet auctions and through funds collected from private and corporate donations.

Members of the diplomatic corps and representatives of 29 charities will be present at the **Grand Award Ceremony** hosted by the Romanian Embassy on May 10th.

"Our proceeds support so many worthy causes, ranging from helping children in institutional care to have successful careers, supporting a youth orchestra where Czech children play alongside children from 6 different nations, efforts to get youngsters off the streets and a bistro that gives a jobs to homeless women," said Mrs. Barbara Marc from Slovenia, DSA President. "These are only a few of the many achievements of our partnering NGOs. It is greatly satisfying to cooperate with them and our thanks go to all our members, volunteers, partners and sponsors, whose work and support makes this possible."

"Our work demonstrates the gratitude of our respective nations for the hospitality of our host country and the Czech people. These NGO grantees are doing excellent work and we hope that our financial donation will help them to continue and stay motivated," noted **Mrs. Tamar Agiashvili from Georgia, DSA Charity Coordinator.**

"Each year we receive more grant applications then we can satisfy. We are therefore very grateful for the help from an increasing number of socially responsible private and corporate donors who entrust their contributions to our care, knowing that **100 percent of their donation goes to charities** and none to DSA operational costs," explained **Mrs. Adriene Petone from Hungary, DSA Treasurer.** "Among our most generous financial donors are Škoda Auto and Hilton Hotel. Other leading companies supported us by donating products to our tables and auctions including Granát Turnov, Preciosa, Moser and many others. For the first time we also had many young Czech artists and designers donating their products for our auction".

The Diplomatic Spouses Association was established in 1997 as a nonprofit organization to enable its members to strengthen relations with the cultural heritage of the host country, to share their own cultural heritage, information, interests and ideas. The Association runs on a voluntary basis and puts a strong emphasis on charity work. Since 2000 the DSA raised close to 66 million CZK, which makes it one of the country's leading benefactors.
